## INTRODUCTION

## **PURPOSE**

These Design and Construction Standards is a guide for the planning and designing of streets, water and sewer systems, stormwater systems, flood controls, erosion control structures, and associated activities for the City of Austell. The guidelines and general design procedures in this manual have been approved and adopted by the City of Austell Mayor and City Council.

### This manual:

- a. Has enumerated design standards that have been authorized by the City of Austell to facilitate the City of Austell's compliance with local, state, and federal regulations.
- b. Identifies submittal requirements and procedures for the review of infrastructure projects within the City of Austell service area.
- c. Serves as a reference document for professional consultants in the design of infrastructure projects within the City of Austell service area.

### DESCRIPTION AND USE OF THESE DEVEL DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS

This manual identifies single set of standards, submittal requirements, and approval procedures to be used in the planning and design of projects within the City of Austell.

This manual is not intended to serve as a step-by-step design methodology nor can this manual address every situation which may arise. The application of sound engineering/surveying principles and judgment combined with the information contained herein are necessary to complete the planning, design, and preparation of related construction documents for stormwater and erosion control projects.

Approval of plans by the City of Austell shall not relieve the design professional or developer from required compliance with the provisions of this manual unless a written variance is received from the City of Austell.
