


**CITY OF AUSTELL
TITLE VI POLICY STATEMENT**

The City of Austell is committed to compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all related regulations and directives. The City of Austell assures that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national, origin, as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 (P.L. 100.259) be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity. The City of Austell further assures every effort will be made to ensure nondiscrimination in all of its programs and activities, whether or not those programs and activities are federally funded. In addition, the City of Austell will take reasonable steps to provide meaningful access to services for persons with Limited English Proficiency.

As provided under section 162a of the Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1973 (Section 324, Title 23 U.S.C.), the City of Austell shall not discriminate on the grounds of sex and the City of Austell shall submit a certification to the Georgia Department of Transportation and/or the Federal Highway Administration indicating that the requirements of section 162a of the Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1973 have been added to its assurances.

When the City of Austell issues contracts and agreements, Title VI language will be included and monitored for compliance.

Austell Public Works is responsible for initiating and monitoring Title VI activities, preparing required reports, and other responsibilities as required by 23 Code of Federal Regulation 200 and 49 Code of Federal Regulation 21.


